RELATING TO POULTRY FOUND TRESPASSING

Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same, That if any person shall find trespassing in his or her premises any geese, poultry or fowls of any description it shall and may be lawful for them so finding said fowls trespassing to kill the same, and if the owner does not claim and take away the same within two hours after notice is given to himself or family, to use the same in like manner as if said fowls had been his, her or their own property.
