RELATING TO THE DEPOSITING OF RUBBISH OR FILTH WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID BOROUGH.

Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same, That if any person shall cart, carry, draw or move or deposit or cause to be done any shavings, mud, straw, ashes, dung, or any dead carcass, offal, excrement or other filth whatsoever on any pavement, footwalk, street or alley within the limits of said Borough, and leave the same there remain, he, she, or they so offending and being so convicted by the Burgess or by a Justice of the Peace, shall forfeit and pay a sum of Two Dollars for every such offence and shall moreover pay the expense of removing such nuisance.

Provided, the party may after conviction, if the same had not already been done by the proper authorities, remove and bury to a depth sufficient to remove any disagreeable smell arising therefrom, the said dead carcass, offal, excrement or filth which if done immediately shall cause a waiver of the latter part of said penalty.
