AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMON SEWER.

Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same:

Sec. 1. That the line or course of that portion of a main sewer pipe heretofore partially fixed by resolution of Council to be constructed from the west side of Green Street to the tail race from the mill of Josiah Heacock at a point near the line of the Millville Creamery Co. be and is hereby established as follows to wit:

Beginning at a point on the west side of Green Street at the intersection with Main Street; thence westerly in said Main Street to Railroad Street; thence southerly in said Railroad Street to Walnut Street; thence through the land of Josiah Heacock near the line of the Millville Creamery Co. to the tail race.

Sec. 2. That a branch be connected with the main pipe mentioned in the first section hereof leading from a point in Walnut Street opposite the lot owned by G. A. Potter, thence westwardly in said Walnut Street to Railroad Street to connect with the main sewer at that point.

Sec. 3. The portion of said sewer from Railroad Street to the tail race shall be constructed at the expense of the Borough, and the portion on Main, Railroad and Walnut Streets shall be constructed at the expense of the property owners along the line.

Sec. 4. That after the construction of the aforesaid sewer and on the petition of a majority of property owners in number and interest on any street or portion of streets adjacent thereto, Council shall by resolution direct that such sewer shall be constructed at the expense of the property owners on the streets.
