AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE, DESCRIBING ITS DUTIES, AUTHORITY AND POWERS, AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF RULES AND REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY SAID COMMITTEE AND Council, AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Millville, Pa., and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That there shall be a committee of Council, three in number, to be known and designated as the "Public Safety Committee"; this committee shall consist of the President of the Borough Council of the Borough of Millville, who shall, ex officio be Chairman thereof, and two members of Council to be appointed by the President of Council as advisory members; the two advisory members of said committee shall be appointed upon the passage of this Ordinance and thereafter at the annual meeting of Council for organization or adjournment thereof; appointment to fill vacancies shall be made by the President of Council at any regular or special meeting of Council.

SECTION 2. The duties of the "Public Safety Committee" shall be to make and establish all rules, regulations and orders for the government, regulation, control and direction of vehicles and vehicular traffic of all and every kind, on and upon, and for the use by vehicles and pedestrians of the highways, streets, avenues, alleys, lanes, crossings and sidewalks in the Borough of Millville, and the general regulation of the same for public meetings, parades, assemblies, and gatherings where public addresses are delivered, public addresses, displays, street shows, vendors, and the regulation of public halls and buildings.

SECTION 3. The "Public Safety Committee" shall have full power to enforce such rules and regulations as may be adopted by said committee and approved by Council; and for this purpose the Chief of Police, and the entire Police Force and Department shall be under the complete charge, control, direction and supervision of, and shall report to the Public Safety Committee, and be subject to its direction; and the chairman of the said Public Safety Committee shall act, do and perform all and every the duties herein provided as, for and on behalf of said Committee; and in case of disagreement between the Chairman of said Public Safety Committee and the advisory members, as to any matter herein, then the decision of the Chairman shall prevail, and control any and every such proceeding.

SECTION 4. Full power and authority is hereby given to, and vested in said "Public Safety Committee" as follows:

A. To make and establish rules, regulations and orders for the government, regulation,

control and direction of vehicles, and vehicular traffic of all and every kind on an upon, and for the use by vehicles and pedestrians of the highways, lanes, alleys, Streets, avenues, crossings and sidewalks in the Borough of Millville, and the general regulation thereof for public meeting, parades, assemblies, gatherings, vendors, shows, displays, public halls and buildings. thereof.

B. To make, establish, control, regulate, suspend temporarily and change from time to time, rules, regulations and orders, for the parking of motor cars and vehicles of every kind.

C. To make, establish, control, regulate suspend temporarily and change from time to time, and enforce through the Police and Fire Departments, rules, regulations and orders for controlling, using or closing of highways, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings and sidewalks when fires occur, and to have complete control thereof.

D. To have full power and authority to enforce, through the Police Department of the Borough of Millville, or other Officers, and all and every of said rules, regulations and orders, approved and published as herein provided; to fix, prescribe, enforce and recover fines, and penalties for violation of said rules, regulations and orders, and to provide for summary hearings thereon.

E. To alter, change, add to, extend, revise, rescind, repeal or temporarily suspend any portion of all of such rules, regulations, or orders from time to time.

SECTION 5. All such rules, regulations and orders, and any and all alterations, changes, additions, extensions, revisions, recisions, repeal or temporary suspension of any portion of all of said "Public Safety Committee" presented to Council at a regular or special meeting for action thereon; and if approved by a majority vote of Council present, the same shall be signed by the President of Council and attested by the Secretary, and after one (1) publication in a daily newspaper published in the County of Columbia, shall thereupon be and become immediately in full force granted, according to the tenor of the provision in said rules, regulations and orders contained.

SECTION 6. In this Ordinance the words "vehicle" and "vehicular" shall include and mean every kind of vehicle, car and method of conveyance, whether on wheels or runners, by whatever power propelled.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and legal publication.

BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE TRAFFIC RULES

RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE  
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE UNDER  
ORDINANCE NO. 56 OF THE BOROUGH  
OF MILLVILLE, COLUMBIA COUNTY, PA.

RULE NO. ONE:

- a. Vehicles shall not be parked on the south side of East Main Street within 83 feet of the intersection of main and state streets.
- b. Vehicles shall not be parked on the North side of East Main Street within 77 feet of the intersection of Main and State Streets.
- c. Vehicles shall not be parked on the East side of North State Street within 85 feet of the intersection of Main and State Streets.
- d. Vehicles shall not be parked on the North side of West Main Street within 56 feet of the intersection of Main and State Streets.
- e. Vehicles shall not be parked on the South side of West Main Street within 56 feet of the intersection of Main and State Streets.
- f. Vehicles shall not be parked on the West side of South State Street within 62 feet of the intersection of Main and State Streets.
- g. No vehicle shall be parked on the West side of North State Street from the intersection of Main and State Streets to the Borough line.
- h. No vehicle shall be parked on the East side of South State Street from the intersection of Main and State Streets to the Borough line.

RULE NO. TWO:

No vehicle shall be parked on Main Street between the Borough Line at the Western extremity of Main Street and Green Street; nor on State Street between Fourth Street and Francis Street, unless the right wheels of such vehicle shall be within six (6) inches of the pavement curb. 19470505.056 Public Safety Committee, establishment thereof.

RULE NO. THREE:

No vehicle shall be driven on any highway, street or ally of the Borough of Millville at a

speed in excess of thirty-five miles per hour; and no person shall drive any vehicle upon any highway, street or alley of the Borough of Millville at such a speed greater that will permit him to bring the vehicle to a stop within the assured clear distance ahead.

**RULE NO. FOUR:**

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the rules and regulations above set forth shall, upon summary conviction before the Chief Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the Borough of Millville, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$10.00 and costs of prosecution; and in default of the payment, thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five days.

**RULE NO. FIVE:**

These rules and regulations shall be in force and effect immediately following publication as set forth in Ordinance No. 56.
