

ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES
FOR WATER SERVICE IN THE BORO OF MILLVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the Boro of Millville, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. From and after April 1, 1961, the following rates shall be charged for water service to customers of the Water System owned by the Municipal Authority of the Boro of Millville, County of Columbia, Pennsylvania, and operated by the Boro of Millville as Lessee:

DOMESTIC AND COMMERCIAL FLAT RATE SCHEDULE

All consumers who have no meters as of April 1, 1961 and subsequent thereto or who have meters that are not working shall be charged according to the flat rate schedule. The flat rate schedule shall be as follows:

- a) All consumers having a maximum of 3/4 inch service or a 5/8 inch meter not working (whichever is larger) shall be charged a flat rate of \$14.25 per quarter.
- b) All consumers having a maximum of 1 inch service or 1 inch meter not working shall be charged a flat rate of \$25.00 per quarter.
- c) All consumers having a maximum 1-1/2 inch service or 2 inch meter not working (whichever is larger) shall be charged a flat rate of \$80.50 per quarter.

When the foregoing connections are for fire service only, only charges under the Fire Service Schedule shall be made.

The flat rate schedule shall also apply to consumers having newly installed meters or repaired meters until the beginning of the next meter reading period following the period in which the respective meter was installed or repaired.

DOMESTIC AND COMMERCIAL METER RATE SCHEDULE

All consumers who have working meters on April 1, 1961 of who are furnished with working meters thereafter shall be charged according to the following meter rate schedule per quarter:

Up to the first 2,500 gallons \$7.50

The next 2,500 gallons at the rate of \$1.00 per thousand gallons.

The next 5,000 gallons at the rate of \$0.75 per thousand gallons.

All water over 10,000 gallons at the rate of \$0.50 per thousand gallons.

COMMON METER RATE SCHEDULE

Each landlord who maintains one meter serving tenant consumers shall be charged for all consumers using the meter (including the landlord if connected to the meter). Such charge shall be the applicable gallons and rates under the Domestic and Commercial Meter Rate Schedule, both multiplied by the number of consumers using the meter. In such cases the landlord shall be responsible for the payment of such water charges to the Boro.

FIRE SERVICE SCHEDULE

From and after April 1, 1961 fire service connections shall be charged according to the following fire service schedules per quarter:

a) Municipal fire hydrants,	\$30.00 per hydrant
b) Private fire service	
For each outside hydrant	\$ 9.00
For each inside hose connection,	2.25
c) Automatic Sprinkling or other Special Service Fire Protection	
For each 1 inch connection	\$ 5.40
For each 1½ inch connection	8.10
For each 2 inch connection	13.50
For each 3 inch connection	21.60
For each 4 inch connection	33.75
For each 6 inch connection	72.90
