AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR USE OF PUBLIC STREETS, ALLEYS, AND ROADWAYS BY THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY OF THE BORO OF MILLVILLE, COUNTY OF COLUMBIA, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, MAINTAINING AND RECONSTRUCTING SEWER LINES WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF SAID STREETS, ALLEYS AND ROADWAYS.

Section 1. The Municipal Authority of the Boro of Millville, County of Columbia, Pennsylvania shall be and it is hereby authorized for itself, its contractors, agents, servants or employees, to construct, maintain and reconstruct sewer lines within the right-of-way of all public streets, alleys and roadways within the Boro of Millville.

Section 2. Whenever said Authority or a contractor operating thereunder, or the agents, servants or employees of the Authority shall open or dig a ditch for the purpose of laying, constructing, maintaining or reconstructing any sewer line, it shall during the period of time said ditch is open or otherwise closed to traffic, maintain proper safeguards against injury or damage to any party or parties by reason of such condition.

Section 3. The Municipal Authority of the Boro of Millville, County of Columbia, Pennsylvania, shall close all such ditches as promptly as possible; shall cause the replaced earth to be properly tamped by mechanical tamping; and restore to the same to grade; and where such street, roadway was paved prior to opening of such ditch, to cause the same to be repaved to conform to the existing pavement.

Section 4 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and legal publication.
