ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE (HEREINAFTER "MILLVILLE") TO JOIN WITH OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS AS A MEMBER OF THE PENNSYLVANIA INTERGOVERNMENTAL RISK MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION (HEREINAFTER "ASSOCIATION") FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT TO FORM A LOCAL GOVERNMENT RISK POOL TO PROVIDE FOR JOINT OR COOPERATIVE ACTION BY MEMBERS RELATIVE TO THEIR FINANCIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING RISK MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND RISK SHARING FACILITIES TO THE MEMBERS AND TO THE MEMBERS' EMPLOYEES, AND TO DEFEND AND PROTECT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT, ANY MEMBER OF THE POOL AGAINST LIABILITY AS OUTLINED IN THE APPENDIX TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the Association was formed in accordance with the authorization contained in the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (1972 P.L. 762, No. 180; 53 P.S. Sections 481 et seq.), initially by the Borough of Bath and the Township of Moore; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act provides that any intergovernmental cooperation agreement shall be deemed in force as to any municipality joining therein, when the same has been adopted by ordinance by all municipalities cooperating therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Millville, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1. Millville shall Join with other municipalities in accordance with the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Act by becoming a member of the Association and by entering into the aforesaid Intergovernmental Contract which is hereby adopted by reference with the same force and effect as if it were fully set forth herein, and a copy of which shall be filed with the minutes of the meeting at which this Ordinance is enacted.

Section 2. Millville is authorized to enter into the Intergovernmental Contract for the purposes contained therein.
The Mayor of Millville is hereby designated as the official authorized to enter into the Intergovernmental Contract on behalf of the Borough of Millville.

Section 3. The Association is designated as having official custody of those funds of Millville which are invested by the Association pursuant to the terms of the Intergovernmental Contract.

Section 4. As required by the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, the Council of the Borough of Millville hereby finds and determines that:

a. The conditions of the Agreement are as set forth in the Intergovernmental Contract referred to and incorporated by reference in Section 1 above;

b. Millville's participation in the Association shall be terminable at any time by ordinance, and shall otherwise continue indefinitely;

c. The purposes and objectives of the Agreement are as set forth herein above and in the Intergovernmental Contract, and the actions contemplated thereby and the purposes and objectives contained therein are legal as part of a pooled arrangement with other governmental units thereby achieving economic and other advantages of intergovernmental cooperation;

d. It is not necessary to finance the Agreement authorized herein from municipal funds of Millville except through the contribution of Millville's Basis Rate (as such term is defined in the Intergovernmental Contract) to the Association;

e. The Association shall be managed by a Board of Commissioners or Executive Committee as set forth in the bylaws of said Association, a copy of which has been provided for review in connection with the enactment of this Ordinance;

f. All property, real or personal, shall be acquired, managed, licensed or disposed of by the Association in accordance with the terms of the Intergovernmental Contract;

g. The Association shall be empowered to enter into contracts for policies of group insurance and employee benefits including social security, for its employees.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its date of lawful enactment.
