MINUTES

Date: May 18, 2021

Time of meeting: 7:00 p.m.

Place of meeting: Boro Hall

The stated meeting of the Millville Borough Council was called to order by President Bower at 7:00 p.m. Also attending the meeting were Council Members Gerald Woolcock, Jim Spangenberg, Wendy Wagner, Ron Girton, Vice-President Jeff Reese & Mayor Craig Omlor. Jen Bodnar was absent.

Employees in attendance: Superintendent Phares, Superintendent Woolcock

Guests in Attendance: Glenda Vansock, Kara & Dan Walsh

Glenda questioned who was in charge of Sewer, wanted to know if there is a record kept of contacts made to the superintendent. Question on who is responsible for doing what. Borough is responsible for mains residents are responsible for the laterals. Problem with lateral that is connected to three houses, who responsible for paying for clogs. Jim told her she needs to check her deed to see who is responsible and will probably have to contact her attorney.

Walsh's checking back to see what has been decided about line painting. State does not regulate parking and line painting. Recommend running a truck thru and see what is needed. Steve and Mike did observe a truck to see what room was needed. Steve Recommends a 60 foot no parking, currently at 40 feet. After a lengthy discussion it was decided it would stay at 40 feet for the time being and if need be, will be revisited at a future meeting.

Street Committee – No truck signs have been posted on railroad. No ordinance needed; we already have one that allows the posting when needed. Mike asked if we could get Sokol in to do street sweeping before carnival time.

Motion: Hire street sweeping at cost not to exceed \$1500 to be done at the discretion of the street superintendents.

Sewer/Water Committee – 2 bids received for water line project. Earthworks was the lower bid and was awarded the project. Change had to be made in pipe which was unavailable so a change order will be submitted. A valve also had to be added. New line is now in operation.

Pool Commission – Cover is off pool is just about filled.

Presidents Report – White Pines visit they have engaged a 3rd party engineer to look over their shoulder. Discussed being proactive versus being reactive as they are now. Jeff discussed communication and transparency issues. Skip asked for a thank you letter to be sent to Legion for the flag and flagpole.

Motion by Jeff Reese, 2nd by Gerald Woolcock. Motion carried.

Motion: Send thank you letter to Legion for flag and flagpole donation at the corner park

Secretary Report - Discussion on opening the restrooms in the park now that restrictions are being lifted. Restrooms to be opened if we are permitted, Beverly to check into restrictions. Corner park work has been started. Cleanup day is May 22nd from 8:00-11:00. Tennis camp has been cancelled. Craig reported tornado siren would not be tested during cleanup. Rob will contact the school and they will coordinate a test with them.
