The stated meeting of the Millville Borough Council was called to order by President Bower at 7:00 p.m. Also attending the meeting were Council Members Gerald Woolcock, Jen Bodnar, Jim Spangenberg (7:16), Wendy Wagner, Ron Girton, Vice-President Jeff Reese & Mayor Craig Omlor.

Employees in attendance: Secretary Lutcavage, Superintendent Phares, Rob Bower

The minutes of the regular meeting held August 17, 201 were accepted and approved. The Treasurer's Report that includes the check register and the Profit and Loss Reports were accepted and approved.

**Motion:** To authorize payment of bills as presented

Police – Report submitted. There will be 2 cameras installed in the park. Borough needs to submit an estimate to repair the gazebo to police for restitution.

Street Committee – Jeff Reese asked about cleaning out the ditch by Henry's at the curve on Woodland. Steve said they are still going to do that, but they have not gotten to it yet.

Sewer/Water Committee – White Pines and their 3<sup>rd</sup> party engineer met with Steve, Mike, Skip, and Travis. Meeting went well they toured the sewer plant. Engineer will send a copy of his report when it is completed. Steve said he had an inspection of the water plant; he and Rob are working to get deficiencies corrected prior to the report being generated. DEP told Rob as the licensed operator he has to be present at the plant more often. Dennis Seig has fixed his sewer line.

Finance Committee – Budget is being worked on. Discussed the rent for Madison Township. The new rate for 2022 will be \$365. Bev to write letter and include a list of things that are covered in the rent and remind them that the use of meeting room is not included.

Motion by Ron Girton 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim Spangenberg. Motion carried

**Motion:** Set the 2022 rate for Madison Township rent at \$365 per month.

Recreation Committee: Jeff Reese is the Chair of the committee. Met with the park commission to discuss needs and care of the park. Possible workday with help from scouts, kids who need community service for school, community service people. Still not sure what they want to do about the fountain. Scouts are still planning on painting the lights before winter. Recreation Committee is recommending the borough bring in an arborist to get advice on what trees need to go and what trees to add. Jeff and Bev had a discussion, and we will be adding \$2000-\$4000 (budget dependent) to the recreation reserve fund to start building that up for the expenses that will be coming in the future.

Secretary Report – I met with Harry Mathias to discuss possible grant monies to do work in the park and at the pool. Will get with the park commission to see what they would like to see as far as equipment in the park. Presented the MMO for both Uniformed and non-uniformed pension.

Good of the Community: Received letter from Bloomsburg Recycling asking for a donation. After discussion it was decided we will not be donating.
