MINUTES

The stated meeting of the Millville Borough Council was called to order by Vice President Reese at 7:00 p.m. Also attending the meeting were Council Members Charlie Hartzel, Jen Bodnar, Jim Spangenberg, Wendy Wagner, & Ron Girton. President Bower and Mayor Wright were absent

Paul Haden II & Shanna Haden voiced concerns regarding the proposed drive thru at the bank on the corner of Main & State Streets. A lengthy discussion followed. Vice President Reese let everyone know that the plans are only in the beginning stages and are with the county planning commission at this time. The borough planning commission met and reviewed the plans and submitted concerns. It was suggested that they also voice their concerns to the county planning commission. Some of the concerns discussed were traffic, parking, lighting & safety. Brief discussion was held on the Rails for Trail program. Dennis Stackhouse brought up an issue from the first week in July of 2017 and was told that council had discussed the incident, the OIC of the police department had investigated the incident and it was determined that there was nothing to pursue. Dennis stated that Rob was not aloud on his property to read the meter. Vice President Reese informed Mr. Stackhouse that residents could not dictate to the borough which employee would read meters.

The minutes of the regular meeting held February 20th were accepted and approved. The Treasurer's Report that includes the check register and the Profit and Loss Reports were accepted and approved.

Street Committee – Start to look at roads for 2018 street project.

Planning Commission – Reviewed plans for drive thru at the bank (Drex Wright). Sent list of concerns to the county planning commission

Personnel – Will place an ad next week for Rob's position and conduct interviews in March

Park Commission – Park Bingo to be held on February 25th.

Pool Commission – No bingo date set yet. They are looking for some new commission members

Request was made to expand the Hamburg stand at the carnival. Discussion was held, park still needs to approve the request.
